Title II's Health and Long-Term Care Programs were merely listed separately for this budget and received a slight decrease in funding.

** Since it does not reflect any congressional earmarks, the President's budget recomment for Title IV is traditionally lower than the prior year's level.

† The President's budget recommends legislative changes that would allow LIHEAP to be automatically increased as economic need requires.
